**A Letter to Rev. Kingsley George-Obilonu from the Office of the Bishop of the Diocese of Tulsa**

Dear Fr. Kingsley, We want to thank you and the parishioners of St. Joseph & St. Paul for participating in the Catholic Relief Service Rice Bowl program this past Lent. 40 communities from our diocese participated in CRS Rice Bowl and raised a total of \$17,931.17 for those living in poverty here and overseas.

Twenty-five percent of CRS Rice Bowl donations stay here in our diocese to help those suffering and Seventy-five percent goes to Catholic Relief Services overseas to aid the poorest of the poor.

Thank you for creating an environment where your parishioners are making Lenten sacrifices that lift our brothers & sisters living in poverty.
